Come along and enjoy the beautiful and picturesque Dandenongs. The walk begins at the famous Ferntree Gully 1000 stairs. After a challenging climb to the top, it continues on through the amazing Dandenongs Temperate Rainforest. You will see some of the tallest trees in the world, and if you're lucky the elusive and stunning Superb Lyrebird.

Morning Tea is in beautiful Sassafras at one of the quaint tea houses in town. Sassafras has a number of gorgeous antique and gift shops that you are welcome to have a browse in before getting back on the trail. The walk continues back to Ferntree Gully where a picnic lunch in the forest awaits us at the finish.

Meet: Ferntree Gully Picnic Area Car park (mel ref:74H4)

Time: 0745 for 0800 start, should be finished by 1400

Included: Experienced guides, morning tea and lunch

Bring: Small backpack or camel back with water, waterproof jacket, snacks and camera

Wear: Comfy walking gear. Runners or hiking boots. Layers are good so you can take them off when you warm up and put them on when you cool down.

Fitness: Capable of walking for around 4 to 5 hours with good breaks at own pace.
